## Authority and Dominion

Mark 5:21-24

**Jairus' desperation allowed him to forget about the**

Romans 5:1, 2 (NKJV) Therefore, having been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ, (2) through whom also we have access by faith into this grace in which we stand, and rejoice in hope of the glory of God.

**Woman, your faith has healed you.**

- Healed: sozo - save, delivered, protect, heal, preserve, make whole
- Peace: eirene - peace, prosperity, quietness, set at one again
- Freed: hugies - health, well, sound, whole, enlarge, and give the increase

Mark 5:34 (AMP) And He said to her, "Daughter, your faith (your trust and confidence in Me, springing from faith in God) has restored you to health. Go in (into) peace and be continually healed and freed from your [distressing bodily] disease."
