2 Kings 4:32-35 (NLT) When Elisha arrived, the child was indeed dead, lying there on the prophet's bed. (33) He went in alone and shut the door behind him and prayed to the Lord. (34) Then he lay down on the child's body, placing his mouth on the child's mouth, his eyes on the child's eyes, and his hands on the child's hands. And the child's body began to grow warm again! (35) Elisha got up and walked back and forth in the room a few times. Then he stretched himself out again on the child. This time the boy sneezed seven times and opened his eyes!
