## Mark 13:1-4

## Mark 13:28-30

**What is the application for us today?**

John 3:36 | 1 Thessalonians 5:9

1 Thessalonians 1:10 ...and to wait for his Son from heaven, whom he raised from the dead--Jesus, who rescues us from the coming wrath.

Daniel 9:20-27 (NLT)

Nehemiah 2:11 (April-May 455 B.C.) **plus** Daniel 9:26 (483 years) **equals** A.D.33

**Daniel 12:1-4** At that time Michael, the great prince who protects your people, will arise. There will be a time of distress such as has not happened from the beginning of nations until then. But at that time your people--everyone whose name is found written in the book--will be delivered. (2) Multitudes who sleep in the dust of the earth will awake: some to everlasting life, others to shame and everlasting contempt. (3) Those who are wise will shine like the brightness of the heavens, and those who lead many to righteousness, like the stars for ever and ever. (4) But you, Daniel, close up and seal the words of the scroll until the time of the end. Many will go here and there to increase knowledge.

## Mark 13:32-37

We are now in the time of the Gentiles and the time of the rapture is near when the Gentile time will be completed. The Lord will begin to pour out His wrath on those who refuse to believe. After the tribulation (Jeremiah 30:7), the second coming of the Lord will take place and the 1000 year reign will begin. 1 Thessalonians 4:16, 17 | 1 Timothy 6:14 | 2 Timothy 4:8

**Revelation 19:11-16** I saw heaven standing open and there before me was a white horse, whose rider is called Faithful and True. With justice he judges and makes war. (12) His eyes are like blazing fire, and on his head are many crowns. He has a name written on him that no one knows but he himself. (13) He is dressed in a robe dipped in blood, and his name is the Word of God. (14) The armies of heaven were following him, riding on white horses and dressed in fine linen, white and clean. (15) Out of his mouth comes a sharp sword with which to strike down the nations. "He will rule them with an iron scepter." He treads the winepress of the fury of the wrath of God Almighty. (16) On his robe and on his thigh he has this name written: KING OF KINGS AND LORD OF LORDS.
