John 18:34-37 (NLT) Jesus replied, "Is this your own question, or did others tell you about me?" (35) "Am I a Jew?" Pilate asked. "Your own people and their leading priests brought you here. Why? What have you done?" (36) Then Jesus answered, "I am not an earthly king. If I were, my followers would have fought when I was arrested by the Jewish leaders. But my Kingdom is not of this world." (37) Pilate replied, "You are a king then?" "You say that I am a king, and you are right," Jesus said. "I was born for that purpose. And I came to bring truth to the world. All who love the truth recognize that what I say is true."
