Are the verses in Mark 16:9-20 really a part of the original text?

Dr. Ivan Panin discovered the following mathematical sequences:

The first 8 verses:

Words	126 (7x18)
Letters	427 (7x61)

Last 12 verses:

Words	175 (7x25)
Letters	553 (7x79)
Numerical Value	106,663 (7x14,809)

Over 15 early church fathers quoted from the last 12 verses and many of the earliest manuscripts contained these verses. (2nd century Peshitto Suriac and the 3rd century Curetonian Suriac)

The most important verification is that the verses have been confirmed by the Holy Spirit in the lives of millions of people.
