(30) And having chosen them, he called them to come to him. And he gave them right standing with himself, and he promised them his glory.

Challenge:

Philippians 2:10 NKJV) ...that at **the name of Jesus** every knee should bow, of those in heaven, and of those on earth, and of those under the earth... *(emphasis added)*

2 Corinthians 3:18 (NLT) And all of us have had that veil removed so that we can be mirrors that **brightly reflect the glory of the Lord**. And as the Spirit of the Lord works within us, we become more and more like him and reflect his glory even more. *(emphasis added)*
