I don't even know where we will go. Go on back and take your troops with you, and may the Lord show you his unfailing love and faithfulness." (21) But Ittai said to the king, "I vow by the Lord and by your own life that I will go wherever you go, no matter what happens--whether it means life or death." (22) David replied, "All right, come with us." So Ittai and his six hundred men and their families went along.
