## Part 4: Prayer for All | Text: 1 Timothy 1:18 to 2:7

### Review: 1 Timothy 1:18-20

1 Samuel 15:23 "For rebellion is like the sin of divination, and arrogance like the evil of idolatry. Because you have rejected the word of the Lord, he has rejected you as king."

Isaiah 38:1, 2 In those days Hezekiah became ill and was at the point of death. The prophet Isaiah son of Amoz went to him and said, "This is what the Lord says: Put your house in order, because you are going to die; you will not recover." (2) Hezekiah turned his face to the wall and prayed to the Lord, (3) "Remember, O Lord, how I have walked before you faithfully and with wholehearted devotion and have done what is good in your eyes." And Hezekiah wept bitterly. (4) Then the word of the Lord came to Isaiah: (5) "Go and tell Hezekiah, 'This is what the Lord, the God of your father David, says: I have heard your prayer and seen your tears; I will add fifteen years to your life.'"

### 1 Timothy 2:1-3

- **Request:** Need, want, asking, entreaty to God or to man: Luke 1:13, Ephesians 6:18
- **Prayer:** Addressed to God, emphasis on our weakness and His strength, also a place of prayer: Revelation 5:8, Acts 2:42
- **Intercession:** Freedom of access and receiving resources of the eternal, catching up, falling into, meeting by chance, joining someone on a journey, relationship: 1 Timothy 4:5, Romans 8:26, Joshua 10:12
- **Thanksgiving:** Gratitude language, giving of thanks: 2 Corinthians 4:15, Philippians 4:6
- **Kings:** We will pray but not worship, we have a republic so we can pray and vote them out.
- **Authority:** Superiority in rank or character, excellence

Acts 2:42 They devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and to the fellowship, to the breaking of bread and to prayer.
