- High Priest Hebrews 4:15, 16; Hebrews 5:5; Hebrews 6:20
- Mediator Hebrews 8:6
- Intercessor Hebrews 7:25; Isaiah 53:12; Romans 8:34
- Advocate 1 John 2:1; John 14:26 (AMP)

Hebrews 4:15, 16 For we do not have a high priest who is unable to sympathize with our weaknesses, but we have one who has been tempted in every way, just as we are--yet was without sin. (16) Let us then approach the throne of grace with confidence, so that we may receive mercy and find grace to help us in our time of need.

Hebrews 7:25 Therefore he is able to save completely those who come to God through him, because he always lives to intercede for them.

### Mediator:

God: Genesis 14:20; Deuteronomy 6:4; Ephesians 4:6  
Mediator: Hebrews 8:6; Hebrews 9:15, 16; Job 9:32-35  
Jesus the Man: John 1:14; Hebrews 4:15, 16; Hebrews 2:17

Hebrews 8:6 But the ministry Jesus has received is as superior to theirs as the covenant of which he is mediator is superior to the old one, and it is founded on better promises.

Hebrews 2:17 (NLT) Therefore, it was necessary for Jesus to be in every respect like us, his brothers and sisters, so that he could be our merciful and faithful High Priest before God. He then could offer a sacrifice that would take away the sins of the people.

### The Lord became a ransom for all men, so we no longer need to live under the bondage of sin.

Hebrews 10:14 (NLT); Titus 2:14; Romans 5:6; Revelation 5:9

Galatians 1:4 ...who gave himself for our sins to rescue us from the present evil age, according to the will of our God and Father...

John 3:14, 15 Just as Moses lifted up the snake in the desert, so the Son of Man must be lifted up, (15) that everyone who believes in him may have eternal life.
