### Dear Friends

These past months, we have been ministering in seminars and different churches in Uganda. This came as a result of Michael teaching twice on Impact Radio concerning the Holy Spirit Baptism. Christians who had never received the Holy Spirit were filled with the evidence of speaking in other tongues. Many others were filled afresh, were delivered from demonic oppression and received healing.

We were invited to minister at a youth conference organized by Compassion International in Luwero district together with the church of Uganda. God loves the see unity and love which crosses denominational lines.

This past weekend, we traveled with another ministry to a rural part of Western Kenya called Oyogis. A two day revival meeting was held there. Much of the ministry on this trip began before we left Uganda. The gospel was preached to the guard who was looking after our luggage and got saved. We preached the gospel in the taxi on the boarder of Uganda and Kenya. Three people accepted Christ in their lives. We also prayed for the sick. At the boarder we preached to Somali Moslems in a restaurant. On our return trip, we shared with a lady who owned a restaurant and found that she was already born again. We told her of God's promise to send the Holy Spirit. She received the baptism of the Holy Spirit with the evidence of speaking in tongues. One of her waiters was also born again and filled with the Spirit.

We encountered a religious spirit in Oyogis in the meeting. Men and women were dressed in long robes and covered their heads with caps or veils. Some wore crosses on their necks and rosary beads. Their day of worship was officially on Saturday although they were not Seventh Day Adventists. We realized they needed sound doctrinal teaching and discipleship. In order to

do that one needs to lay down a completely new foundation. Still people were delivered from demonic spirits and received prayers for healing.
