Jesus came into a great celebration, but very few understood what the significance was of the *Triumphal Entry*.

Exodus 12:3-11

The blood was for covering and protection; the flesh was strength for the journey. The lamb had to be perfect and pass a three-day examination. 1 Peter 1:18, 19

Leviticus 22:21 (NLT) If you bring a peace offering to the Lord from the herd or flock, whether to fulfill a vow or as a freewill offering, you must offer an animal that has no physical defects of any kind.

John 6:51 - Eat of my flesh

John 1:29 | Isaiah 52:13-53:12

John 3:17 (NKJV) For God did not send His Son into the world to condemn the world, but that the world through Him might be saved.

John 6:52-58 - Reflecting on His death

1 Corinthians 11:25, 26 | Hebrews 2:9

Hebrews 9:26 (NLT) If that had been necessary, he would have had to die again and again, ever since the world began. But no! He came once for all time, at the end of the age, to remove the power of sin forever by his sacrificial death for us.

John 15:4 | 1 John 2:24 | Genesis 3:16, 17

John 6:57 - Father gave life to Son

John 5:19-30 | John 5:26 | John 17:18 John 15:9 (NLT) "I have loved you even as the Father has loved me. Remain in my love."

John 6:48 - Supernatural food

1 Corinthians 10:3 | 1 Corinthians 10:16

Matthew 4:4 (NKJV) But He answered and said, "It is written, 'Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceeds from the mouth of God."

Galatians 3:13, 14 | Deuteronomy 21:22, 23

The death of Jesus not only took care of our sin, but also the consequence of sin in our lives. (penalty and power)

Leviticus 16:21, 22 | Colossians 1:13, 14 | Mark 2:8-12

Joshua 8:29 He hung the king of Ai on a tree and left him there until evening. At sunset, Joshua ordered them to take his body from the tree and throw it down at the entrance of the city gate. And they raised a large pile of rocks over it, which remains to this day.

John 5:24 "I tell you the truth, whoever hears my word and believes him who sent me has eternal life and will not be condemned; he has crossed over from death to life."

John 5:26 "For as the Father has life in himself, so he has granted the Son to have life in himself."
