Saved - Sozo: Eternal life, delivers from bondage of sin, protects, healing, preserve, be whole, be safe, sound, peace and harmony, and all the blessings given to men by God in Christ.

Past - Penalty of sin: Hebrews 10:14; Ephesians 2:5

Present - Power of sin: Romans 6:6; Romans 6:14

Future - Presence of sin: 1 John 3:2, 3; John 14:3

2 Chronicles 5:11-14 (NLT) Then the priests left the Holy Place. All the priests who were present had purified themselves, whether or not they were on duty that day. (12) And the Levites who were musicians--Asaph, Heman, Jeduthun, and all their sons and brothers--were dressed in fine linen robes and stood at the east side of the altar playing cymbals, harps, and lyres. They were joined by 120 priests who were playing trumpets. (13) The trumpeters and singers performed together in unison to praise and give thanks to the Lord. Accompanied by trumpets, cymbals, and other instruments, they raised their voices and praised the Lord with these words: "He is so good! His faithful love endures forever!" At that moment a cloud filled the Temple of the Lord. (14) The priests could not continue their work because the glorious presence of the Lord filled the Temple of God.
