

# THE DAY OF PENTECOST

## Part 3: Ourpouring Text: Acts 2:1-8

### Leviticus 23:15-21

- 50 days
- 2 loaves
- Celebration of harvest

### 2 Chronicles 5:4-6 and 11-14

- Establishment of a place of Worship
- Giving of offering as a thanksgiving
- Praise and worship to the faithfulness of the Lord

2 Chronicles 5:4-6 and 11-14 When all the elders of Israel had arrived, the Levites took up the ark, (5) and they brought up the ark and the Tent of Meeting and all the sacred furnishings in it. The priests, who were Levites, carried them up; (6) and King Solomon and the entire assembly of Israel that had gathered about him were before the ark, sacrificing so many sheep and cattle that they could not be recorded or counted. (11) The priests then withdrew from the Holy Place. All the priests who were there had consecrated themselves, regardless of their divisions. (12) All the Levites who were musicians--Asaph, Heman, Jeduthun and their sons and relatives--stood on the east side of the altar, dressed in fine linen and playing cymbals, harps and lyres. They were accompanied by 120 priests sounding trumpets. (13) The trumpeters and singers joined in unison, as with one voice, to give praise and thanks to the Lord. Accompanied by trumpets, cymbals and other instruments, they raised their voices in praise to the Lord and sang: "He is good; his love endures forever." Then the temple of the Lord was filled with a cloud, (14) and the priests could not perform their service because of the cloud, for the glory of the Lord filled the temple of God.

Acts 2:1-8 When the day of Pentecost came, they were all together in one place. (2) Suddenly a sound like the blowing of a violent wind came from heaven and filled the whole house where they were sitting. (3) They saw what seemed to be tongues of fire that separated and came to rest on each of them. (4) All of them were filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other tongues as the Spirit enabled them. (5) Now there were staying in Jerusalem God-fearing Jews from every nation under heaven. (6) When they heard this sound, a crowd came together in bewilderment, because each one heard them speaking in his own language. (7) Utterly amazed, they asked: "Are not all these men who are speaking Galileans? (8) Then how is it that each of us hears them in his own native language?"
