- Seven sevens: 49 years 495-396 B.C. (Artaxerxes' decree to arrival of Nehemiah)
- Sixty Seven: 434 years 396 B.C. to 32 A.D. (Dedication of Second Temple to the crucifixion of Jesus)
- One Seven: 7 years unfulfilled

Psalm 18:25-27 (NLT) To the faithful you show yourself faithful; to those with integrity you show integrity. (26) To the pure you show yourself pure, but to the wicked you show yourself hostile. (27) You rescue those who are humble, but you humiliate the proud.

Ephesians 2:8,9 | 1 Corinthians 15:10 | Ezekiel 36:23-30

Ezekiel 36:23-30 I will show the holiness of my great name, which has been profaned among the nations, the name you have profaned among them. Then the nations will know that I am the Lord, declares the Sovereign Lord, when I show myself holy through you before their eyes. (24) "For I will take you out of the nations; I will gather you from all the countries and bring you back into your own land. (25) I will sprinkle clean water on you, and you will be clean; I will cleanse you from all your impurities and from all your idols. (26) I will give you a new heart and put a new spirit in you; I will remove from you your heart of stone and give you a heart of flesh. (27) And I will put my Spirit in you and move you to follow my decrees and be careful to keep my laws. (28) You will live in the land I gave your forefathers; you will be my people, and I will be your God. (29) I will save you from all your uncleanness. I will call for the grain and make it plentiful and will not bring famine upon you. (30) I will increase the fruit of the trees and the crops of the field, so that you will no longer suffer disgrace among the nations because of famine.
