We see two important ingredients necessary for our daily walk revealed:

Loyalty: 2 Thessalonians 1:4Believe: 1 Corinthians 15:16, 17

• Hope: 2 Corinthians 5:7 | Hebrews 11:1

: Right standing: A judicial act of God, by which he pardons all the sins of those who believe in Christ (all sins have been pardoned but only those who believe in Christ can receive the benefit of this forgiveness). He accepts the believers and treats them as ones who have right standing in the face of the Laws' demands. The offenses are not set aside but considered fulfilled by the sacrifice of Christ on the cross. The believer who is acquitted is entitled to all the rewards resulting from perfect obedience. (Easton Dictionary)

The Lord treats me not as a sinner to be punished but as a son to be loved. The Lord does not look on me as a lawbreaker to be obliterated but as a person to be saved. (Barkley Commentary)
